## Immediate Response Checklist

# Crisis Communication Templates

Adapt these templates to communicate effectively during a content leak:

## Template 1: Initial Statement

## Template 2: Acknowledgment and Action

"We acknowledge the recent content leak and are taking immediate action to protect our community and intellectual property. Takedown requests have been submitted, and we are investigating the source of the leak."

## Template 3: Empathy and Transparency

"We understand that the recent leak may be concerning. We want to assure you that we are doing everything in our power to rectify the situation and prevent future incidents. We value your trust and loyalty."

## Template 4: Emphasising Copyright

"It has come to our attention that proprietary content has been illegally leaked and distributed without authorization. We are doing everything in our power to address the breach and the copyright infringements arising. We request that you kindly disregard, and do not share or engage with the illegal content. Thank you for your understanding."
